“Introduction to Green Plumbing & Green Mechanical Concepts”

Course Description:

This seminar is designed to introduce participants to the basics of the Green Building movement as well as Green Plumbing and Mechanical concepts, products, and installations. Participants will learn about the present trend towards green construction, what it means to be green, and the major organizations supporting green technology and practices.

The discussion of Green Plumbing will focus on the need for green applications, water conservation and water conserving methods, and the link between water conservation and energy conservation. Some of the Green Plumbing concepts covered in this discussion include, but are not limited to, reduced volume fixtures, low-flush toilets, low-flow and waterless urinals, gray water systems, reclaimed water, and water heating.

The Green Mechanical portion of the program will focus on energy conservation and indoor air quality. Some of the Green Mechanical concepts covered in this discussion include, but are not limited to high efficiency boiler systems, high efficiency forced air systems, thermal mass and storage, geothermal applications, and solar heating.

Seminar Presenter:

Seminar presenter Michael Mitchell has been involved in the plumbing trade since 1973. He is the senior plumbing inspector for the City and County of San Francisco since 2000. With half of his career spent in contracting, and the balance on code enforcement, Mike brings a wealth of practical knowledge to his classrooms. Besides various certifications in inspections, he also holds a Doctorate of Jurisprudence, specializing in Civil Procedure.



An assistant professor at the College of San Mateo, California where he leads the Inspection of Plumbing course, Mike also teaches at UA Local 467 in Trade Related Math and the Plumbing Code and was a Code instructor for the PICC. Mike's teaching style is orientated toward team building skills and collaborative leadership. He has an extensive background in community-based organizations and in presenting city and county programs to local constituents.
