SUBJECT: Final Ballot Results for the Association Action Ballots – 2018 UPC

Dear Technical Committee Members:

Attached are the Final Ballot Results for the committee actions taken at the Association Technical Meeting.

29 Members Eligible to Vote. All Ballots were received by the closing date of October 12, 2017. (See *attached ballots for details*)

There are two criteria necessary to pass the letter ballot for each item as follows:

1. The number of affirmative votes needed for each item to pass is 2/3 affirmative.
2. In all cases, an affirmative vote of at least a simple majority of the total members eligible to vote is required.

The following committee actions based on the association amendments failed to achieve the necessary 2/3 affirmative votes of returned ballots.

Item 192, Part 1, failed to achieve the necessary 2/3 affirmative votes of returned ballots (received 12 affirmative votes)

29 Members eligible to vote - 7 not returned - 0 abstention = $22 \times 2/3 = 14.7$ or **15** affirmative

29 Members eligible to vote $\div 2 = 14.5$ or **15** simple majority

Item 192, Part 2, failed to achieve the necessary 2/3 affirmative votes of returned ballots (received 13 suitable votes)

29 Members eligible to vote - 8 not returned - 0 abstention = $21 \times 2/3 = 14$ or **14** suitable

29 Members eligible to vote $\div 2 = 14.5$ or **15** simple majority

In accordance with Section 4-6.1(c) of the Regulations Governing Committee Projects, Item 192 will be automatically docketed as an appeal to the Standards Council.
