This appeal will argue for the removal ASSE 1072-2007 from the Mandatory Reference Standards, Table 14-1 in the 2009 UPC.

During the 2009 UPC final action hearings in Atlanta on Oct. 1, 2008 it was discovered that a standard had been included in table 14-1 for a product that had been voted out of the code by the membership at the hearings. The Technical Committees' rejection of the 2008 ROC Item 146, page 147 was upheld by the membership, thereby rendering ASSE 1072 useless to code officials. It represents a standard for a product that has been denied inclusion in the 2009 Code.

This discrepancy was discovered on page 218 of the 2008 ROC. When I asked if this could be remedied during the hearing I was informed that due to the nature of this change it would have to be addressed via the appeals process. The remedy I seek is the removal of any reference to ASSE 1072-2007 in the 2009 UPC.
