



**Summary of Substantive Changes
between the updates dated March 1, 2013 and August 5, 2013 of
UL 962, “Household and Commercial Furnishings”
(Third edition, dated July 7, 2008)**

Presented to the IAPMO Standards Review Committee on September 9, 2013

General: The changes to this standard should not have an impact on currently listed products. The major changes are:

- Revised enclosure requirements for products powered by a class 2 power supply (see Section SA3.1)
- Added requirements for bed heating systems (see Supplement SD)

Section SA3, Enclosures: Added exception enclosures on the load side of less than 15 watt source or class 2 luminaries as follows:

SA3.1 Flammability

Exception No. 3: Enclosures are not required as specified in footnote b of Table SA3.1.

Table SA3.1, Enclosure Flammability: added footnote (b) to 15 watt or less column and Class 2 Luminaries as follows:

Footnote *b Enclosures are not required on the load side of the power source; but if provided shall be rated HB minimum.*

Supplement SD, Indirectly Heated and Cooled Bed Systems: Added requirements for systems that utilize air heating and cooling to heat and cool a bed.
