### **IAPMO Seeks USPSHTC Slip-Resistance Task Group Members**

**Ontario, Calif. (Aug. 13, 2019)** — The International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO®) is accepting applications and seeking technical experts to participate in a task group relating to slip resistance.

The scope of the Slip-Resistance Task Group is to review the applicability of various slip-resistant surfaces. Also, research will be conducted to determine if additional applicable standards are available for the purpose of developing public comments for technical committee consideration.

Task group members will participate via conference call or web meeting, provide their perspective on the code, and assist in drafting recommendations for action by the *Uniform Swimming Pool, Spa and Hot Tub Code (USPSHTC)* Technical Committee. Applicants are not required to be members of the *USPSHTC* Technical Committee.
