

Summary of Substantive Changes between the 2019 and the 2020 edition of ASSE 1023 "Electrically Heated or Cooled Water Dispensers"

Presented to the IAPMO Standards Review Committee on June 14, 2021

General: The changes to this standard should not have an impact on currently listed products. The significant changes are:

Clarified requirements for instant capacity water heaters (see Sections 3.2.1, and 4.2.2)

Section 3.2, Instant Capacity for Heated Water: Clarified requirements for instant capacity water heaters as follows:

3.2.1 Purpose

The purpose of this test is to verify the manufacturer's claims of the device's instant capacity. This test is only for devices that include a water heater <u>and shall be performed only when the manufacturer includes the claim in their literature or on product marking</u>

Section 4.2, Installation and Maintenance Instructions: Clarified requirements for instant capacity water heaters as follows:

4.2.2

The installation instructions for the device shall include the following information:

- 1) Inlet connection size.
- 2) Maximum working pressure.
- 3) When applicable, For heated water, the instant capacity.
- 4) When applicable, the continuous capacity for cooled or heated water.
