## IAPMO Code Change Monographs Now Available

Ontario, Calif. (March 24, 2014) — The International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO $^{\circ}$ ) has made the 2014 *Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC^{\circ})* and *Uniform Mechanical Code (UMC^{\circ})* Technical Committee Meeting Monographs available for download.

All individuals anticipating an active role in the ANSI-accredited consensus development of the *Uniform Codes* at the Technical Committee meetings in Las Vegas, April 28-May 1, will need to download this document in Adobe PDF format from <a href="http://www.iapmo.org/Pages/default.aspx">http://www.iapmo.org/Pages/default.aspx</a>. Hardcopy versions will not be available at the meetings.

The Technical Committee Meeting Monographs contain every public comment submitted for the 2015 editions of the *UPC* and *UMC* as part of the American National Standards Institute (ANSI)-accredited consensus code development process employed by IAPMO.

Public comments on the *UPC* address: roof drainage pipe sizing provisions; steps for using the new medical gas and vacuum sizing tables; material, water consumption and referenced standard requirements for plumbing fixtures; applying "wet location" to showers without thresholds; parallel distribution systems; firestop materials; and revised Appendix A water pipe sizing provisions.

Public comments on the *UMC* address: condensate control; ventilation; parking garage provisions; hydronic heating and cooling systems; flexible air ducts; smoke and fire dampers; several public comments involving specific appliances; and refrigeration.
